

Family Planning Benefit Program (FPBP)

Family Planning Benefit Program (FPBP) is a free health insurance program. It lets teens and most adults get private family planning care.

FPBP insurance will pay for:

- Birth control
- Plan B (emergency contraception)
- STI testing, counseling, and treatment
- HIV testing and counseling
- Pregnancy testing and counseling
- Screenings (tests) for cervical cancer
- Physical exams (regular check-ups)
- Getting to and from family planning doctor visits

FPBP will not pay for:

- HPV shots
- Fertility treatments (to help you get pregnant)
- Care for pregnant women
- Abortion

If you need services that FPBP does not pay for, talk to your CHN Health Educator. We can connect you to care.

You can sign up at the front desk of any CHN health center. We don't need your documents today. We just need to know:

- Your sex
- Your age
- Your income (how much money you make each year)
- Your address
- How many people live in your house
- If you are a US citizen or if you were not born in the US
