Chest Binding

Binding unsafely can cause breathing problems, broken ribs and can cause your lungs to fill with fluid.



Tips for binding safely:

- Don't use Ace bandages or duct tape! They aren't meant for binding, they don't
 move with your body, and can cause you harm.
- Don't wear a binder that's too small for you.
- Only wear 1 binder at a time.
- Don't bind 24/7! In fact, don't bind for more than 8-12 hours at a time. It is better for your body and your binder will last longer too!
