

Doxy-PEP

What is Doxy-PEP?

Doxy-PEP is like a safety shield after sex.

- It lowers your risk of getting sexually transmitted infections (STIs) you could get from sex, like syphilis, gonorrhea, and chlamydia.
- If you were assigned male at birth and have sex without a condom in the past 3 days, Doxy-PEP can help protect you from getting an STI.
- Think of it as a morning-after pill, but for STIs.



Can I take Doxy-PEP?

You can take Doxy PEP if:

- You were assigned male at birth.
- Had unprotected sex in the last 72 hours.

Do and Don't with Doxy-PEP

Do:



- Do take with food and water to help with upset stomach.
- Do take one dose (two pills together) within the first 24 hours of sex without a condom for full effect.
- Doxy-PEP can still be taken within 72 hrs of sex without a condom

Don't:



- Don't share your medicine with others.
- Don't take antacids or multivitamins 2 hours before or after.
- Don't take more than one dose a day.
- Don't take with milk.

Things to keep in mind:

- Continue to schedule your routine STI testing for safety.
- Doxy-PEP can be taken with PrEP.



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
